THE TOWERS OF CALELLA

Explore the Calella ruins, a climb that's somewhat steep yet manageable at a relaxed pace. The rewarding view at the summit justifies the ascent. Enjoy an extensive vista encompassing Calella's coastline, its bustling center, and the lighthouse, stretching for miles ahead.



CALELLA LIGHTHOUSE

Situated along the beach, Calella's lighthouse offers picturesque vistas of the village's coastline. During May's race event, the lighthouse opens solely on Saturdays and Sundays from 10 am to 2 pm. Yet, the stroll to this scenic spot is worthwhile for the stunning views, even when the lighthouse is closed.



DALMAU PARK

Calella's expansive park spans over eighteen hectares, comprising pine and oak forests. Discover serene spots to unwind, sitting on benches beneath the tree canopy. Revel in the vibrant hues of diverse flowers while being serenaded by the melodic symphony of birdsong.



SHOPPING DISTRICT

Calella boasts the Costa Brava's lengthiest shopping promenade, extending over two kilometers. Hosting over 500 shops, predominantly clothing and souvenir stores, it offers an extensive array of sights. Situated in the old city quarter, it's a bustling hub for exploration and retail therapy.

At NUI Beach you can eat directly on the beach. There is an English menu and mainly local dishes are served. Enjoy the paella while enjoying a drink with a view of the sea. Another recommendation is the salmon and the fideua. Guests also like the cocktails.

Just like NUI Beach, Bahari Club is a good chringuito, or beach bar. In this modern, stylish restaurant you can enjoy simple, but tasty Catalan dishes. While enjoying a glass of sangria you can enjoy the rushing sea in the background.

Roda has been a household name in Calella for more than 60 years. It is a real traditional Spanish restaurant run by a local family. People are particularly pleased with the chicken - according to guests, the chicken here is the tastiest they have ever eaten. The sangria is also popular.


CAMP NOU
