ABOUT THE CIRCUIT



Situated in Spielberg, Austria, the Red Bull Ring is a 4,318-meter circuit featuring 10 turns. The undulating terrain results in height variances of up to 69 meters, adding a significant level of technical challenge to the track.

The track features three DRS zones: one after the start/finish straight, another between turns 3 and 4, and a third after turn 10. With lap times just over a minute, there is no time for rest. The racing is continuous, ensuring spectators are captivated from beginning to end.

The track is made for speed, featuring long straights where drivers can push the boundaries of their cars, guaranteeing thrilling overtaking maneuvers and constant excitement for spectators.



HOW CAN I REACH THE CIRCUIT?

The most convenient way to reach the Red Bull Ring is by car. Parking is free and the parking lots are located within a 10-15 minute walk of the circuit. <u>Parking lots</u> open one hour before the circuit's opening times each day.

Public transportation is also an option. Take the train to Knittelfeld station. From there, free shuttle buses run directly to the circuit. Shuttle buses depart every 30 minutes from 8:00 AM to 8:00 PM throughout the weekend. From 8:00 PM to 11:00 PM, shuttle buses depart hourly. On Sundays, shuttle buses run until 7:00 PM only.

Please be aware of traffic congestion on race weekends. Allow extra time for your journey.

ENTRANCE GATES

There are six entrances providing access to the Red Bull Ring. These are indicated on the map on page 11 as green check marks, or "Ticket Control".

Present a valid ticket when entering the circuit. Tickets are electronically verified, and you have the option to display them on your mobile device. Nevertheless, it is recommended to have a printed copy of your ticket as a precaution in case your phone malfunctions unexpectedly.



The circuit is open on the specified days:

- Thursday from 12:00 to 19:30
- Friday from 07:00 to 20:00
- Saturday from 07:00 to 20:00
- Sunday from 07:00 to 20:30



SANITARY FACILITIES

There are sufficient (temporary) toilets available on the circuit. Look out for signs directing you to the nearest toilet. In general, the toilets are kept very clean. The toilets can be very busy during a Grand Prix weekend, espeically right before a Formula 1 session.

TAKING PICTURES

It is allowed to take photos on the circuit with a simple camera for personal use. Pay attention to others and avoid obstructing their view. Be respectful to fellow spectators.

FOOD AND DRINKS

The finest array of food and beverages in Spielberg is located in the Fan Zone. Typically, a variety of delicious Austrian dishes such as schnitzels, burgers, and bratwurst are available here at prices that are generally reasonable by F1 standards.

The circuit employs a cashless system utilizing a wristband for payments, which can be recharged using cash or a debit/credit card.

Food and beverages can be brought to the circuit, but they must not be in glass containers or bottles. Bringing personal alcohol onto the circuit is also prohibited.







WEATHER AND CLIMATE

The average temperature in Spielberg during June is around 23°C (73°F), with highs reaching up to 26°C (79°F) on the warmest days. Rain is possible in June, but with a low probability, the chances of a sunny race weekend are high. Be sure to check the latest weather forecast before you travel.sweater.



Similar to Australia, drivers and team bosses arrive on Race Day via the "Styrian Green Carpet." Between 09:00 and 11:00 on Sunday, they gather near the Welcome Center, situated close to the Styrian Village (refer to map on page 11).

Get ready to experience the electrifying atmosphere of Formula 1 at the Red Bull Ring's F1 Fan Zone, located near the first corner of the track. This vibrant hub is a haven for motorsport enthusiasts, offering a captivating blend of interactive activities, official merchandise, and food options.

SUGGESTED ITEM TO BRING ALONG


- ID-card or passport;

- Camera (maximum lens length 20 cm)
- Portable charger
- Reusable water container

PROHIBITION ON CARRYING.

- Aerosol cans (except small deodorant)
- Alcoholic beverages
- Bags or backpacks larger than 15 liters; luggage and trolleys
- Camera lenses larger than 20cm
- Cans, metal and glass bottles
- Coolboxes
- Dangerous objects
- Drugs
- Electronic cigarettes/cigars
- Fireworks, smoke bombs, rockets, laser pointers, stadium horns
- Flagpoles and parasols (Over 1 meter or sharp point)
- Harmful and flammable substances
- Pets (Animals)
- SLR cameras or video cameras (Professional without permission)
- Tents and sleeping bags
- Vehicles (bicycles, scooters, etc.)
