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# HUNGARORING



## ABOUT THE CIRCUIT



The Hungarian Grand Prix in Budapest has been part of the Formula 1 calendar since 1986. The race is held at the Hungaroring in Mogyoród, near Budapest.

The 4.381-meter-long Hungaroring is situated in a valley, offering a great view of much of the track. The circuit is very narrow and features 14 challenging corners.

Additionally, it is the slowest track in the Formula 1 championship after Monaco. The Hungarian Grand Prix in Budapest is primarily a test for the chassis.

# PRACTICAL

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## HOW DO I GET TO THE CIRCUIT?

### By Car:

From Budapest, take exit 19 off the motorway and follow the signs for the circuit. Ample parking is available on-site.

### By Taxi:

The Hungaroring has an official partnership with Bolt, a popular taxi app. Download the Bolt app to conveniently book a taxi ride to the circuit.

### By Public Transportation:

- Take the metro line M2 towards the eastern terminus, Örs vezér tere.
- Upon reaching Örs vezér tere, follow the red S8 signs and take a short walk through an underpass to the HEV station. Ticket offices and a large shopping center (ideal for stocking up on water and snacks) are located nearby.
- Board the H8 train heading towards Gödöllo.
- Disembark at Kerepes station to utilize the free shuttle bus service to Gate 3 of the Hungaroring.
- The complimentary shuttle buses also depart from Gate 3, but now travel to Gödöllő train station. Here, you can connect with a wider range of trains back to Budapest.
- Take the HEV train back to Örs vezér tere (where you can interchange with the metro) or to Budapest's central railway station, Keleti Pályaudvar.

## ENTRANCE GATES

There are seven entrances that provide access to the Hungaroring, marked as "Gates" on the map on page 11. If you travel to the circuit with our transfer bus, you can enter through Gate 8.

Show a valid ticket upon entry to the circuit. Tickets are electronically scanned, and you can show them on your mobile phone. However, it is recommended to always carry a printed copy of your ticket.

# PRACTICAL

## SANITARY FACILITIES

The circuit has plenty of (temporary) toilets available. Follow the signs to locate the nearest restroom. Generally, the toilets are well-maintained. However, during a Grand Prix weekend, it can get very crowded at the restrooms, especially just before a Formula 1 session.

## TAKING PICTURES

You are allowed to take photos at the circuit with a simple camera for personal use. Be mindful of others and avoid obstructing their view. Please be respectful to fellow spectators.

## FOOD & DRINKS

Food at the Hungaroring has significantly improved in recent years, but it is still not exceptional. For Hungarian standards, it is on the pricier side. In addition to hotdogs and hamburgers, there is now more variety, including langos (Hungarian fried flatbread), gyros, and pizzas.

Expect to pay €5-10 for most meals. In 2023, a half-liter of beer cost around 1300 Forints (a little over €3). Water and soft drinks are slightly cheaper, and there are free water refill stations in the Fan Zone. You can pay with cash or a debit card. You are also allowed to bring your own food and drinks, with a maximum of half a liter of beverage in a plastic bottle and food for personal consumption.



# PRACTICAL

## WEATHER & CLIMATE

During the F1 race in Hungary, you can expect warm temperatures between 25 and 30°C, with occasional temperatures above 30°C. The sun often shines, but short, heavy thunderstorms can also occur. Be aware that it can be cooler in the mountains, so bring a sweater for the evenings.

## FAN ZONE

The F1 Fan Zone is located between Silver 5 and Silver 6. Here, you will find interactive activities, merchandise stands, and food outlets. The Fan Zone is a vibrant hub where fans can enjoy entertainment and experience a sense of connection with the world of Formula 1.

## OPENING HOURS

In 2023, the circuit opened at 7 a.m. every day. Unfortunately, the opening hours for 2024 are not yet published.

## F1 APP

# PRACTICAL

If you are unsure about which items are allowed, you can refer to the list below. Prohibited items must be surrendered at the circuit entry gates. The circuit staff reserves the right to add other items to the list. Your cooperation is appreciated to ensure a safe and enjoyable experience for all visitors.



## RECOMMENDED TO BRING

- Identification (ID)
- Your (printed) ticket
- Hat or cap
- Sunscreen
- Comfortable (walking) shoes
- Ear protection
- Camera (lens max. 20 cm)
- Power bank
- Refillable water bottle

## PROHIBITED ITEMS

- Alcoholic beverages
- Cans, metal and glass bottles
- Camera lenses larger than 20 cm
- Drugs
- Electronic cigarettes/vapes
- Dangerous items
- Pets
- Coolers
- Harmful and flammable substances
- DSLR cameras or video cameras
- Aerosol cans (deodorant, insect repellent, etc.)
- Bags or backpacks larger than 15 liters; luggage and trolleys
- Tents and sleeping bags
- Flagpoles and umbrellas
- Vehicles (bikes, scooters, etc.)
- Fireworks, smoke bombs, rockets, laser pointers, stadium horns
