ACTIVITIES IN GRAZ

THE SCHLOSSBERG

The main attraction of Graz is the Schlossberg. During the time of Napoleon, the castle that was located here was partly demolished, but a number of parts remained standing. See the Red Bull hanging on the mountain near the cable car.

AIOLA UPSTAIRS
