





So you might be planning to go to the Monza Grand Prix and wonder which tickets you should get. Then this ticket tip guide might help. Here we will provide you with useful tips when selecting tickets for the Grand Prix.

Besides this there is a short overview per grandstand to give you an idea of what the views are with different ticket options. Good luck selecting your tickets. If there is anything you need help or support with, don't hesitate to reach out!





01. TICKET TIPS

To help you select the right tickets and get you well prepared for your trip to the Monza Grand Prix, we have compiled a few ticket tips:

- Ø
- All grandstands (plus some General Admission Areas) offer views on a large TV screen
- Children aged 11 and under get free access to the General Admission areas. However, you still need to reserve a free ticket if you order one yourself.
- Grandstand tickets for children (age 0-11)

 are cheaper. However, they're only bookable in combination with a full price ticket.
- Day tickets for grandstands on Saturday or Sunday are available on request.

 Saturday tickets for the stands are affordable. Consider these if you are unable to attend on Sunday.
- Sunday grandstands tickets are about the same price as three-day tickets. So that is why we do not recommend these tickets.
- Fans in wheelchairs will have free access to the General Admission Areas. All weekend long! Grandstand N25 is the area for wheelchair users.






02. GRANDSTAND TICKET TYPES

Below you will be able to find an overview of the different types of tickets which are available at the Italian Grand Prix in Monza. Along with this you can find information on the views that the different tickets offer and if it is worth the price you pay for it.

Monza offers a wide selection of grandstands. However, they group around only a handful of the main turns on the circuit:

- Around Prima Variante (first chicane).
- Seconda Variante (second chicane).
- Variante Ascari (Ascari chicane).
- Parabolica (last corner), as well as the grandstands next to start-finish.
- General Admission tickets at Monza GP are good despite a lack of elevated viewpoints. Keep in mind that you would have to arrive early to get a good spot.

GRANDSTANDS

PIT STRAIGHT

The Monza Circuit features eight grandstands along the start-finish straight (Rettifilo Grandstand). This zone caters to a range of budgets, including the pricier covered central grandstands. You will have an excellent view of the start-finish line, but less on-track action.

Are you a cost-conscious racing fan? Please consider stands without reserved seat numbers (free seats).

CENTRAL GRANDSTAND AREA

The expansive covered Central Grandstand (Grandstand 1) is the most expensive. Flanking this central stand are the Left Lateral (Grandstand 4) and Right Laterals (Stands 26, 27, 28, 29, and 30). Pricing correlates with the views offered.

Left Lateral lies beyond the start line. The premium Right Lateral stand is closest to the start line. The cheaper grandstands in this area locate more towards the right. Thus, near the exit of the final Curva Parabolica bend.

For optimal stage celebration views, we recommend the Right Lateral stand (Grandstand 26c). This is the most affordable one. All these stands provide cover.



PISCINA

Midway between the start-finish and turn 1 is Piscina (Grandstand 5). Honestly, this is a less recommended and budget-friendly option. At the opposite end of the same straight, closer to the Parabolica exit, is the covered Vedano (Grandstand 24). This grandstand is a better choice for a slightly higher cost.

PRIMA VARIANTE GRANDSTANDS

Monza has five grandstands at the first chicane, Prima Variante:

- Three stands position on the inside of the circuit (Alta Velocita A, B & C or Grandstand 6A, 6B, and 6C).
- Two locate on the outside (Esterna Prima Variante A & B or Grandstand 8A and 8B). These grandstands, known for their outstanding views, come with higher prices. This is partly because of their popularity.

For the inside of the circuit, Alta Velocita C (Grandstand 6C) is the top choice. You can find this grandstand directly behind a section of the old Monza circuit.

Alta Velocita B (Tribune 6B) and Alta Velocita A (Grandstand 6A) are farther from the bend. However, they still provide good views. Because of the location, these grandstands are more budget friendly.

Grandstands on the outside

On the outside of the circuit, a large grandstand has two sections. Esterna Prima Variante A (Grandstand 8A) and Esterna Prima Variante B (Grandstand 8B). 8A grandstand offers a superior track view compared to grandstand 8B. However, it does also come at a higher cost.

SECONDA VARIANTE GRANDSTANDS

Inside the circuit at the second chicane, known as Seconda Variante, after the third corner in Monza you can choose from two grandstands. From here, you witness the F1 cars emerging from the high-speed Curva Grande corner.

This is a lengthy bend that offers multiple racing lines, before braking for the chicane. Hence, it provides excellent overtaking opportunities. The Seconda Variante (Grandstand 9) is a superior choice compared to Roggia (Grandstand 10).

However, these stands are a bit further from the central action. It takes at least 30 minutes on foot to reach these stands from most entrance gates.

GRANDSTAND 10BIS

Grandstand 10bis offers a great view of turn 7 which has provided a lot of action in the past because it is the corner before the second DRS straight. It is therefore important to get a good exit.

GRANDSTAND 11

Grandstand 11 is located on the second DRS straight. However, it does not give you the best view as you will have a limited view of the corners.

VARIANTE ASCARI GRANDSTANDS

Eight grandstands are positioned inside the circuit near Variante Ascari, the fast eighth corner in Monza. People love this corner for its overtaking opportunities.

- The prime views are in the middle of the bend at the Ascari Uno grandstand (Grandstand 15).
- Ascari Tre (grandstand 12) is located at the entrance and close to the track.
- Ascari Due (grandstand 13) is located behind the gravel trap in the middle of the corner.
- Ascari (grandstand 16) positions at the exit.

The outer Ascari stands (Stands 18, 19, and 20) are on the straight between Variante Ascari and Curva Parabolica. Uscita Ascari B (grandstand 19) and Uscita Ascari C (grandstand 20) are small covered stands. In conclusion, there are better views available for the same price.

CURVA PARABOLICA GRANDSTANDS

Approaching the final corner, Curva Parabolica, in Monza. There are five temporary and one permanent (covered) grandstand. You can find these on the outside the circuit.

This corner is one of the most famous on the current Formula 1 calendar. Tickets for the permanent and covered Parabolica (Grandstand 22) are closest to the bend. The prices of the Laterale Parabolica Grandstands depend on the proximity to the final turn.

- Laterale Parabolica A (grandstand 21A) is closest to the turn. It is preferable to Laterale Parabolica B (grandstand 21B) for the same price.
- Are you looking for Monza GP tickets in the lower price range? Then laterale Parabolica C (grandstand 21C) is a better choice than Laterale Parabolica D (grandstand 21D) or Laterale Parabolica E (grandstand 21E).
- Two additional grandstands are inside the circuit at the exit of the Parabolica corner. This is near the entrance to the pit lane. The two grandstands are pretty similar. Hence, the more affordable Parabolica Interna A (grandstand 23A) is a superior choice to Parabolica Interna B (grandstand 23B).

GENERAL ADMISSION (PRATO)

The General Admission Tickets (standing) at Monza give you the freedom to move around the circuit. This is especially true during 'Free Friday'. Then you can occupy a seat in any stand irrespective of your ticket.

Are you willing to cover considerable distance on foot during the weekends? Please discover fantastic viewing spots. From there you have a direct line of sight to the track action and the picturesque surroundings.

Please note: exploring the circuit is more convenient on Friday. This before the influx of Ferrari fans for qualifying and the race.

Within the general admission areas, there are numerous small bleachers and raised viewing spots. A complete F1 experience at Monza involves a stroll through the forest to the farthest section of the circuit. Here, you canl enjoy the view from the Curve di Lesmo (turns 4 and 5). Additionally, the general entrance area on the inside of Curva Parabolica is a noteworthy viewing recommendation.
